Visit to The WildLife Experience Center April 24 & 25

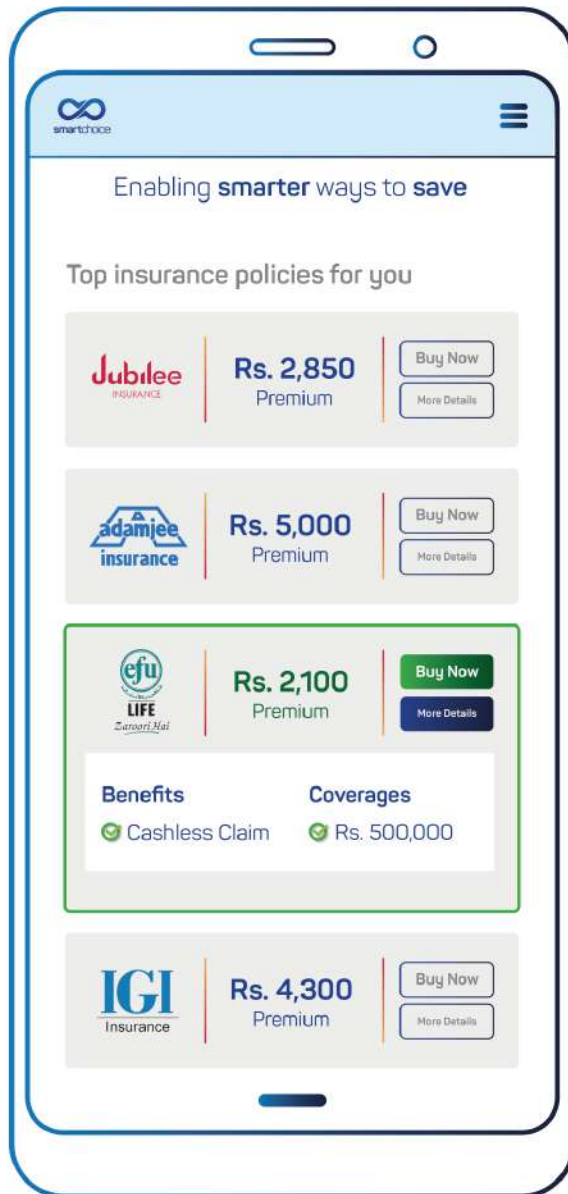
- Students of Fatimiyah Montessori System took a trip to The Wildlife Experience Center - TWEC which turned out to be an interactive and fun learning experience for the kids.

- Along with position holders, students who made the maximum use of library books were awarded "Best Library Users Award" to encourage the habit of reading and research.



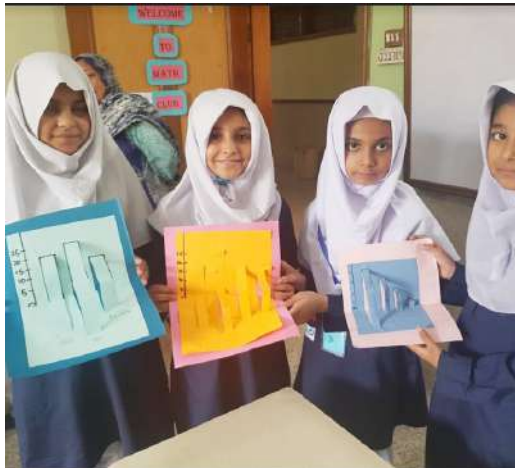
Milad on the Wiladat of Imam Mehdi (عجل الله تعالى فرجه الشريف) April 19

Operating a Ventilator: Basic and Waveform Analysis Session

April 20 & 27

- Sessions on how to operate ventilators, including mechanical ventilation and waveform analysis, were facilitated by Ms. Shahwar Khan, Respiratory Therapist at M/s. Noor International.
- The sessions, attended by RMOs and Nursing Staff of Fatimiyah Hospital, included practical demonstrations on different parameters of a ventilator and the critical role it has in the care of patients specially premature infants and cases involving burn and trauma.



Nutritional Management in Diarrheal Disease of Children April 23

- A session on Diarrheal diseases, in children under the age of five, was conducted by Dr. Samar Hasan, Consultant Pediatrician at Fatimiyah Hospital. The session was attended by RMOs and Nursing Staff.
- The session involved understanding the critical nature of diarrhea especially in malnutrition and child mortality, and how it can be

prevented with measures including safe drinking-water, adequate hygiene and sanitation.

- Attendees were also briefed on the treatment and management of diarrhea due to lactose intolerance, a type of sugar present in milk.

What is Diabetes?

Managing the disease process & progression

April 29

- Dr. Urooj Imam, MSA Manager, Roche Diagnostics conducted a session on the importance of a healthy lifestyle and the myths surrounding diabetes for the Nurses and Paramedical Staff of Fatimiyah Hospital.
- Importance of creating a comprehensive strategy to incorporate screening, prevention and treatment of type-2 diabetes at a community level was also discussed in the session.
- Roche Diagnostics also conducted a 2-day educational activity for the patients of FH which included diet awareness and BMI (Body Mass Index) Measurement.

- A total of 170 nikahs have been registered with Jamaat in the last 10 months, from July 2018 to April 2019.

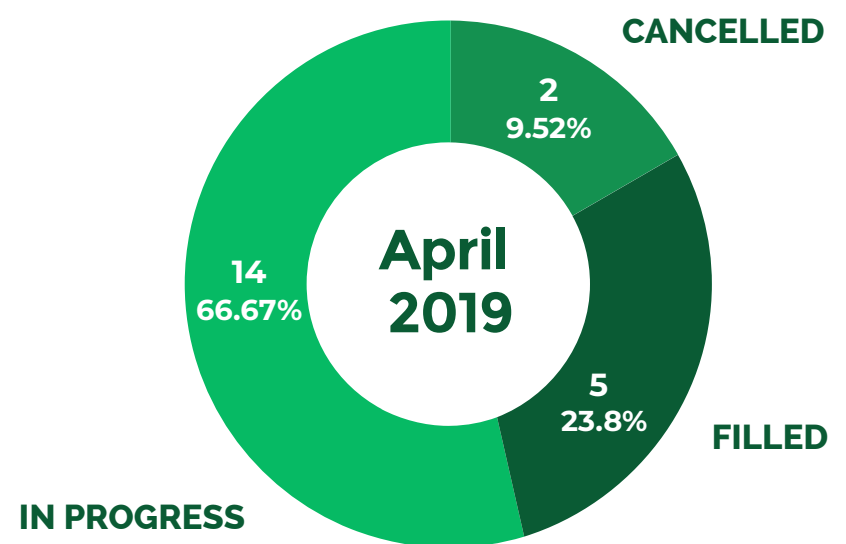
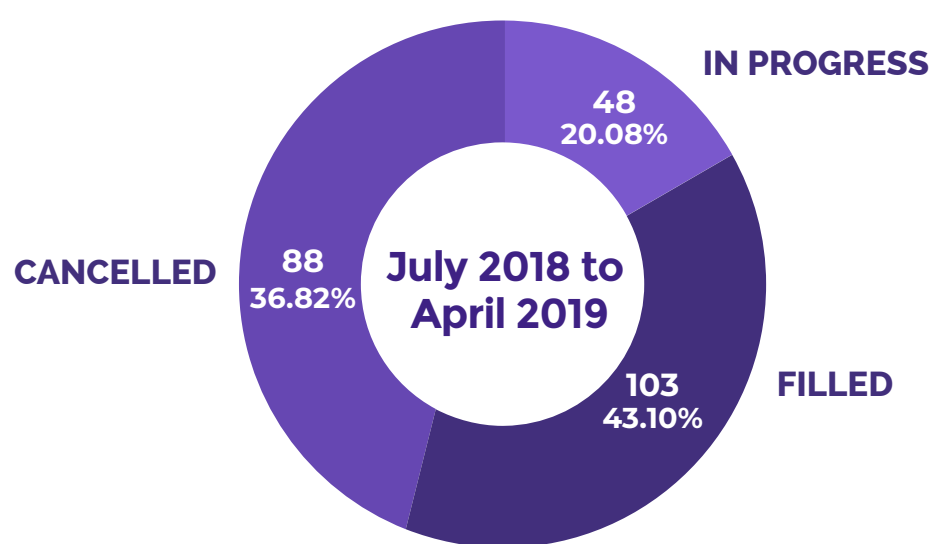
