A BRIEF BIOGRAPHY OF IMAM HUSSAIN (A.S.)

Imam Hussain (A.S.) is the son of Imam Ali (A.S.) and Hazrat Fatimah (S.A.), the daughter of holy Prophet MUHAMMAD (P.B.U.H.).

He is the second grandson of the prophet MUHAMMAD (P.B.U.H.) and he is the holy Prophet's third caliph successor; after his father and brother HASAN (A.S.) Like his father and brother, he is the Imam (Leader) of the people. Imam Hussain (A.S.) is the father of the nine Imams who followed him in succession.

He was born in Medina on the third of the month of Sha'ban, in the third year of Hijra - 624 CE.

On the day of Ashura, while suffering from extreme thirst, he was brutally killed and his head severed by the swords of the army of Yazid-bin-Muawiyah on Saturday, the 10th of Muharram in the year 61 after Hijrah, (around 681 CE) - in Karbala, Iraq.

His son and successor, Imam Ali ibn HUSSAIN, ZAIN UL ABIDIN (A.S.) prepared his headless body, after being left in the field for three days, and buried him in the fields of Karbala, where his shrine stands today.

The Holy Prophet (S.A.) has said in the praise of Imam Hasan (A.S.) and Imam Hussain (A.S.)

"My two grandsons are the delight of my eyes."

"Hasan and Hussain are the leaders of the youth in Paradise."

"Hasan and Hussain are both Imams whether they rise up or not."

He was the most knowledgeable and the best worshiper among the people of his time. He would pray one thousand Rak'ahs every night like his father, and on many nights he would carry sacks of food

to the needy, to the extent that the marks of carrying heavy sacks were clearly visible on his back after his death. He was very kind, had a great and forbearing personality, and was hard on those who disobeyed ALLAH.

When a bedouin Arab came to Imam Hussain (A.S.) seeking help, he recited the following poem for the Imam:

He will not be disappointed who makes a request to you.

For you are generous trustworthy, and your father was the killer of profligate and corrupt individuals.

If it was not for the former (members) of your (Family), we would still have been in hell.

Then Imam Hussain (A.S.) while avoiding eye contact with the man, gave him four thousand gold coins (Dinars) and apologized to the man saying:

Take this and accept my apologies, and rest assure that you have my sympathy. If I were in a different situation and had more (money) to offer you, I would have given you far more.

Through his courageous revolution, the like of which the world has never seen, he revived Islamic Laws and the religion of his grandfather, and furthermore he revived all the people to come until the Day of Judgment. He is the leader of the martyrs and the best among people after his elder brother.

Throughout his life the Muslims used to revere and adore Imam Hussain (A.S.), and used to see in him what they had seen in his grandfather, the Messenger of Allah (P.B.U.H.). Their adoration for Imam Hussain was not just because he was the grandson of the prophet (P.B.U.H.), but also because he was the

manifestation of the teachings of Islam and the conducts of the Messenger of Allah (P.B.U.H.). No one could fail to see examples of the highest moral qualities in his behavior.

The holy Prophet has said in the praise of Imam Hussain (A.S.):

"Hussain is from me and I am from Hussain."

Chroniclers and historians have stated that Imam Hussain (A.S.) was the manifestation of noblest manners and conduct, and vast knowledge, which he inherited from the Messenger of Allah (P.B.U.H.). His actions spoke before his words.

Imam Hussain (A.S.) was humble, gracious and generous. He always supported what was right and stood against what was wrong. People admired his perseverance, forbearance, and magnanimity. He was the most pious and God-Fearing of all people of his time.

In his book Master of the people of Paradise Dr Ahmad Ashur says:

"If you browse through the pages of the Sihaab books you can not fail notice many ahadith about the merits and superiority of Imam Hussain (A.S.) and the love of the Messenger of Allah (P.B.U.H.) for him."

In his book "Al-Furaf Al-Mubimwah" Ibn Al-Sabbagh Al-Maliki, quotes Anas ibn Malik who said "I was with Hussain (A.S.) when a servant entered with a bouquet of basil in her hand. She saluted Hussain (A.S.) and gave him the bouquet. Hussain (A.S.) said to her "you are free for the sake of Allah". I said to Hussain "She gave you a bouquet of basil and saluted you and you set her free?" He said, "This is how Allah has taught us! Almighty says: If you are saluted, salute back in a better way or return the same salute", and the better

way is to set them free."

In his Chronicles, Ibn Asaakir reports that Imam Hussain (A.S.) used to receive money (Khums and Zakat) from Basra and other areas, and he used to distribute the money to the poor and the needy there and then.

Imam Hussain (A.S.) is best known for his revolt against the status quo. By that time the socio-political situation had deteriorated to an extreme and intolerable state, fundamental measures needed to be taken.

The main aim and objectives of Imam Hussain's revolt, which are in fact the aim and objectives of Islam at any time and in any place, may be summarized as follows:

- * To bring about a responsible community in order to implement and convey the message and teachings of Islam.
- * To build an Islamic society which considers Islam as its sole source of reference.
- * To rescue the Islamic civilization from deviation.

This is because the Islamic Ummah (Community) suffered from various diseases in different domains:

* In the social domain it suffered widely from corruption, bribery, cheating, oppression, favoritism and nepotism.

* From the law and order point of view, criminals were not being prosecuted, and therefore crime was rampant.

* From the ethical viewpoint, they had turned the moral values upside down.

* From the economic viewpoint, the ruling elite and their cronies monopolized the wealth of the nation.

It was for these reasons and for the fact that the Muslims had remained indifferent to these issues to the extent that these had become the norm, that Imam Hussain (A.S.) rose against the injustice and corruption that was being conducted in the name of Islam.

In the course of his jihad in the cause of ALLAH, Imam Hussain (A.S.) was brutally beheaded and his body mutilated, alongside his sons, relatives, and some seventy of his followers. Furthermore the

women and children, who were subsequently captured, including Imam Hussain's sisters Zainab (A.S.) and Umm-e- Kolsoom (A.S.) as well as Imam ZainulAbidin (A.S.), were taken as prisoners and paraded in towns and villages as villains.

And since then the movement of Imam Hussain (A.S.) has inspired reform movements against despot rulers all over the world. The Muslims continue to reap the fruit of the event of Karbala and every year during the month of Muharram the memory of Ashura is commemorated with vigour by hundreds of millions of Muslims all over the world.

MEDIA A BLESSING OR A MENACE?

This is a question which is haunting all of us. No doubt, in this modern digital age, we cannot even think of a media-less world. Modern media has revolutionized our lives. We now have news from round the world at our finger-tips. We can communicate with our relatives from across the oceans as if they were in our own bedrooms. We can deliver messages instantly - long gone are the days of the old fashioned letters and postcards. Entertainment comes cheap and easy. Hundreds of channels are offering a range of options. Cooking shows, women shows, talk shows, puppet shows and sporting events - you can literally choose your pick. However, it is also important to realize the costs that this overload of information and knowledge can incur on one's individuality and perception of events.

As the saying goes all that glitters is not gold. It is a proven fact that even the most beneficial thing can be utilized negatively to give drastic results given the malicious intent of the user. Media, for many, is now a destructive agent, and is responsible for many a vices in the society. The fusion of other cultures in ours has caused us to deviate from our moral values. Adapting virtuous characteristics from others is commendable, but problem arises when religious boundaries are crossed and there is unrestricted and undesired cultural invasion. This causes communities to lose their identity and individuality.

The youth of our country maybe unaware of their own background and the history of Pakistan, but thanks to the media, they are well acquainted with the customs of our neighbouring country. Many scenes which routinely appear on the screen are ethically, morally and religiously unacceptable and should not be shown. These tend to create a negative impression on the tender and innocent minds of our youth and ultimately their personality is destroyed. The exposure directs their thinking process into new tracks that can affect their character-building. It is the duty of parents to keep an eye on their children to save them from the harmful effects of the media. It is also the prime responsibility of the government to implement laws to safeguard our ideology and culture in the society. Programs that blur the differentiation between right and wrong, and good and evil should be banned.

Most media channels today are run as business entities meaning that their entire focus is on profit generation. They try to create hype in their news casting and generate an atmosphere of undue excitement to increase their viewership. Honest and seasoned journalists would agree on the importance of a more responsible attitude towards news reporting.

Controlled and run commercially, media can make or break a person, create or erase a fashion, sell or stop a product. It thrives on selling obscenity and nudity and lures the masses to waste hours on non entities. It can make news out of petty issues, and let the most significant news go unattended if it is in the interest of the people behind the scene. It is now no hidden fact that the major media of the world are under Imperialist and Zionist control and even our local media is under their influence. The most important matter concerning the Muslim Ummah today is the Palestine issue. Do you notice how much time is spent by our news channels on this matter? The wave of Islamic awakening has brought about a technical regime change in certain countries, while other countries continue to burn. How many minutes are given in our news to the protests raging in Bahrain and Saudi Arabia?

One of the most important obligations of the media is to be responsible in the items it publishes. The flames engulfing many Asian and African countries today over the movie 'Innocence of Muslims' would never have been kindled in the first place had the relevant websites and channels refused to broadcast a clip which was clearly derogatory and was sure to have violent implications. Had the video been immediately blocked, its impact would have died naturally and there would not have been this reaction, and loss of precious lives and property.

How many of us have borne the frustration of sitting in front of a news channel waiting for an important piece of news which we know has occurred, while the news caster spends away minutes after minutes on turtles and whales? I can still remember the torture when we had heard of the bomb blast on the shrine in Samarra in 2006, and were fervently flicking channels to know the details, while not a single channel even had a foot note. Even now the genocide of Shia muslims in Pakistan and our protests largely go unnoticed by the media, while a rickshaw driver climbing a pole to protest for an increase in his wages makes breaking news on all channels. Although there has been a surge in news channels, this usually becomes more of a menace than a blessing. It is vital to be able to interpret the facts from the multitude versions of any event broadcasted from different channels. One has to be smart enough to read between the lines. A key subject which is taught to religious scholars is 'Ilm e Rajal' where before interpreting any Hadith or acknowledging its authenticity the student finds out all about the narrator, his character, political affiliations and the given situation. Same applies to our setting. Before accepting any bit of news we should realize who is reporting it, and what possible interest might be there in quoting it in that context.

The solution does not lie in boycotting all media or closing our eyes to the problem. We ultimately have to face the challenge by developing a media which can not only provide news as it happens without adding opinion irrespective of interests or affiliations, and portray correctly our values and beliefs, but also provide healthy and clean entertainment to our youth, create awareness in our masses, spread education and help raise our voice in the world. No doubt, some small steps have been taken in this regard, but there is a long way to go.



HEALTH ALERT! BRAIN EATING AMOEBA IN TOWN!

Recently ten deaths have been reported in Karachi due to a rare disease called primary amoebic meningoencephalitis (PAM), a brain infection that leads to the destruction of brain tissue and which is caused by *Naegleria fowleri*.

Last year too, nine deaths attributed to this disease were reported in Karachi. Similarly, in 2008-2009, 13 cases of PAM were reported in the city. According to microbiologists, most of these patients had no history of water sports, and infection probably occurred during ablution with tap water.

With this recent scare and the availability of poor quality water in our tap lines, we thought it would be appropriate to enlighten our readers with a brief update about the disease and its prevention. You may find the following information useful which has largely been taken from the website of Centre of Disease Control (CDC).

What is *Naegleria*?

Naegleria is an amoeba (single-celled living organism) commonly found in warm freshwater (for example, lakes, rivers, and hot springs) and soil. Only one type of *Naegleria* infects people: *Naegleria fowleri*.

How does infection with *Naegleria fowleri* occur?

Naegleria fowleri infects people when water containing the amoeba enters the body through the nose. This typically occurs when people go swimming or diving in warm freshwater places, like lakes and rivers. The *Naegleria fowleri* amoeba then travels up the nose to the brain where it destroys the brain tissue.

You **cannot** be infected with *Naegleria fowleri* by **drinking** contaminated water. *Naegleria* infections may also occur when contaminated water from other sources (such as inadequately chlorinated swimming pool water or heated and contaminated tap water) enters the nose.

Where is *Naegleria fowleri* found?

Naegleria fowleri is found around the world. The amoeba can be found in:

- Warm freshwater, such as lakes, rivers and springs
- Warm water discharge from industrial plants
- Naturally hot drinking water sources
- Swimming pools that are poorly maintained, minimally-chlorinated, and/or un-chlorinated
- Water heaters. *Naegleria fowleri* grows best at higher temperatures up to 115°F (46°C) and can survive for short periods at higher temperatures.
- Moist soil

Naegleria fowleri is not found in salt water, like the ocean..

When do *Naegleria fowleri* infections most commonly occur?

While infections with *Naegleria fowleri* are very rare, they occur mainly during the summer months of July, August, and September.

Can infection spread from one person to another?

No. *Naegleria fowleri* infection cannot spread from one person to another.

What are the symptoms of *Naegleria fowleri* infection?

Naegleria fowleri causes the disease primary amoebic meningoencephalitis (PAM), a brain infection that leads to the destruction of brain tissue. In its early stages, symptoms of PAM may be similar to symptoms of bacterial meningitis. Initial symptoms of PAM start about 5 days (range 1 to 7 days) after infection. The initial symptoms may include headache, fever, nausea, or vomiting. Later symptoms can include stiff neck, confusion, lack of attention to people and surroundings, loss of balance, seizures, and hallucinations. After the start of symptoms, the disease progresses rapidly and usually causes death within about 5 days (range 1 to 12 days).

What is the fatality rate for an infected person who begins to show signs and symptoms?

The fatality rate is over 99%.

How is the disease diagnosed?

Cerebrospinal fluid or CSF is required for diagnosis. A simple test is to see the amoeba under a microscope. There are other more complex tests as well, but the results take time to come.

Is there effective treatment for infection with *Naegleria fowleri*?

It is not clear. Several drugs are effective against *Naegleria fowleri* in the laboratory. However, their effectiveness is unclear since almost all infections have been fatal, even when people were treated with similar drug combinations.

Is there a rapid test to detect *Naegleria fowleri* in the water?

No. It can take weeks to identify the amoeba in water, but new detection tests are under development.

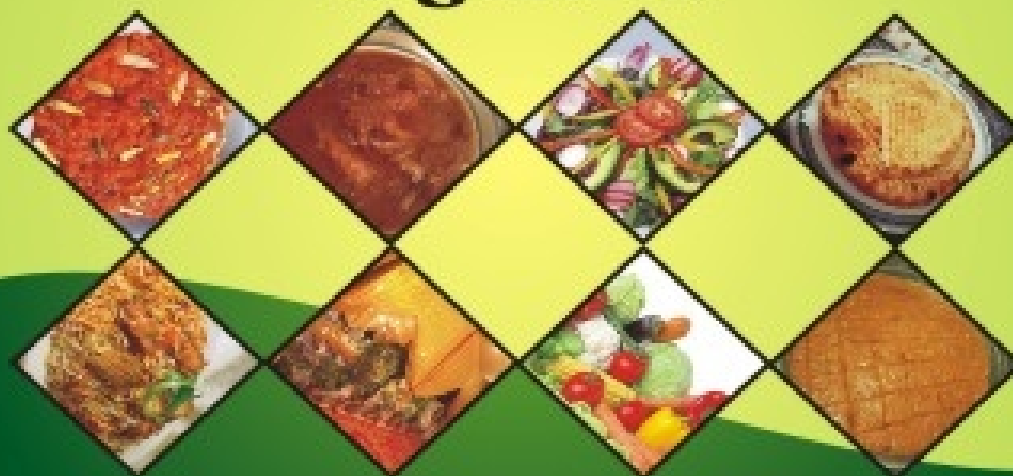
How can one reduce the risk of catching infection?

- Regularly clean and chlorinate over-head and under-ground water tanks.
- The amount of chlorine required is about two drops per litre of water. You can use the usual bleach available in the market for this purpose.
- Use boiled, filtered or chlorinated water for nasal cleaning.
- Avoid water activities in unmaintained and un-chlorinated pools. Chlorine level in swimming pools should be about six times greater than that of tap water and you should be able to smell chlorine.
- Use nose clips while swimming and avoid submerging your head in the water.

SHAMA'S WEDDING

(This story is based on a real incident)

There once lived a small and happy family, comprising of Nilofer a widow, Zahid her son and Shama her only daughter. Her husband had died a few years ago, but he had been wise enough to build a house for the family in his life time. Zahid was by now an accountant in a private company, earning enough to take care of household expenses. Nilofer was a house-wife while Shama was a twenty year old graduate girl. They were all leading a comfortable and contented life.

One day a proposal arrived for Shama. All family members were absolutely delighted. Soon date for wedding was also finalized. Zahid discussed wedding arrangements with his family to arrange required expenses. Nilofer wanted to spend extravagantly on her daughter's wedding. The total expenses were estimated to be around five lac rupees. This included different functions, wedding venue and dinner, jewelry, clothes and miscellaneous items to marry her sole daughter with 'dignity'. Although Zahid had a decent job, yet he was falling short of required expenses for her sister's marriage. So after debate, they decided to stay within their budget and to cut down on wedding arrangements.

Next day Nilofer's neighbor, Rasheeda, visited them. On hearing about the proposal, she started to give routine advises. "This is the matter of a girl's marriage. You must give Shama enough to earn her respect in her in-laws. You must celebrate the ceremony in such a way that people acknowledge your financial status." These words reawakened Nilofer's desire for a lavish wedding.

That night, when Zahid came home, Nilofer pressured him to make all arrangements that were initially decided. Zahid objected that they did not have enough cash to finance such a marriage, but Nilofer persisted and said

"You are both the father and son of the household, and have to fulfill your responsibility with dignity. A marriage happens only once in a life-time. The daughter gets greater respect from her in-laws if her family spends good money on the marriage. We would get more respect in our family and social circle. If she doesn't get required dower, my daughter will have to go through lots of pain in her in-laws and I will not allow that to happen.

I don't care from where you arrange finance. If you don't do it, I will not talk to you anymore and one day when you return home, you will find your mother dead."

Shama also begged her brother to arrange required cash, so that she could have her dream wedding.

Zahid dearly wished to make his sister happy on her wedding day. He discussed the high cost of wedding with Munnu Bhai, the caterer, and mentioned that he was financially in a tight situation. Munnu bhai offered to arrange a loan from a bank in 15 days. Reluctant to take such an important decision on his own, Zahid first discussed the issue with his mother. Nilofer was least bothered with the details of the agreement.

"Do whatever is required to get the money," she said.

Half heartedly, Zahid signed loan papers without clearly understanding terms and conditions. He gave house papers as collateral, and was mentally at ease that with his current job he would be able to pay installments without any problem.

Zahid got the loan and Shama's marriage was solemnized happily.

After two months the company Zahid was employed in filed for bankruptcy. As a result he lost his job and was unable to pay bank instalments. Pressure started to mount as bank demanded its money back. It worsened when he received threat that his house will be auctioned if payment was further delayed.

Zahid shared the problem with Nilofer. Instead of helping to solve the problem, she started blaming Zahid for pledging the house papers against the loan.

Zahid started to become very depressed because of joblessness and the daily harassment from bank as well as taunting words of his mother. One day Shama visited her mother's home along with her husband Shakir. Out of courtesy, Shakir enquired about Zahid's job. Nilofer did not want to reveal facts to her son-in-law. So she replied with a blatant lie that Zahid was progressing well and would soon be getting a car from his office. Suddenly, the door bell rang. It was a bank representative who had come to collect money. The family was very embarrassed, but they had to beg for more time. Shakir too became upset and started cursing Nilofer and Zahid for having lied to him.

Reeling under immense mental pressure and smacking insult from Shakir, Zahid got up and went to his room. Unable to find solace anywhere, he hung himself from the fan and died.

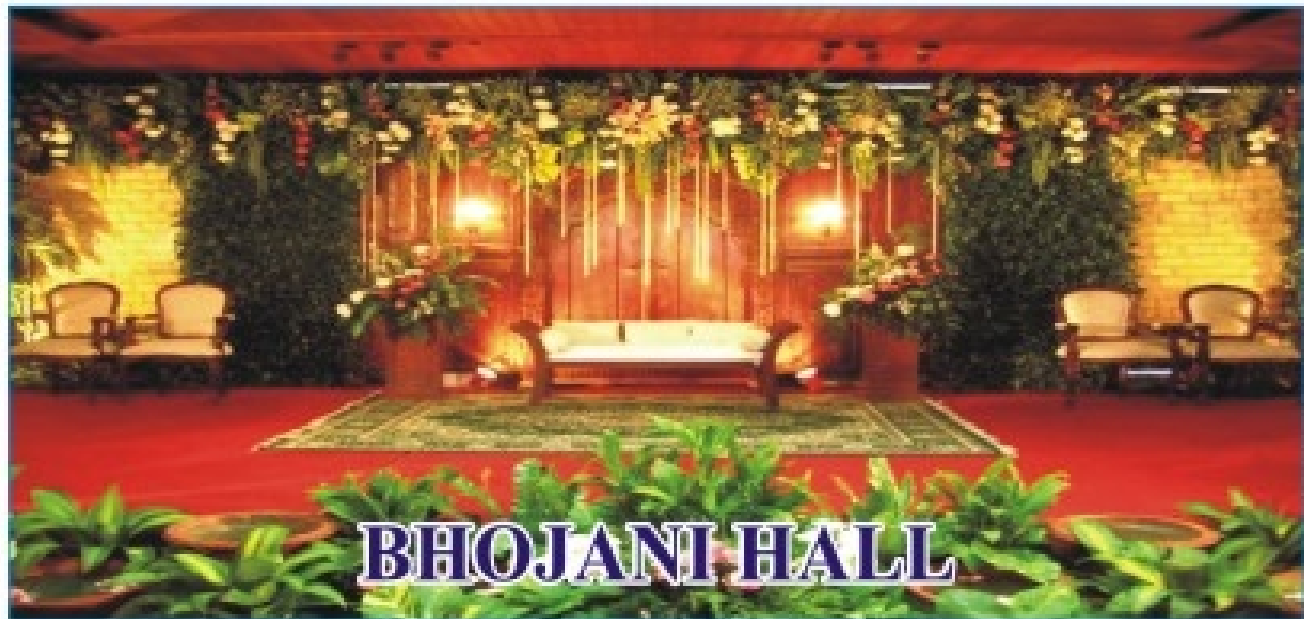

Achievements (brief report) Jan - Sep 2012



Bismillah ir Rehman ir Raheem

The objective of this brief report is to provide information about the academic activities and achievements of Fatimiyah Education Network from Jan-Sept. 2012. It highlights our strengths and identifies areas for development and improvement.

Students Strength: During the last three years there has been a substantial increase in the number of students. Since 2008, more than 730 students were added to various classes. The numbers increased from 2650 to 3387 students. (Approx 22% increase). Afternoon shift at Fatimiyah College with more than 100 admissions (Boys & Girls) began this year (2012) to facilitate the students who could not avail seats in the morning shift.

Academic Improvement Initiatives

In order to improve academic standards, an exercise to review our existing curriculum and books was initiated. As a result of the recommendations, new English, Mathematics, Science and Computer Studies Textbooks were introduced in the primary section and new English & Computer Studies Textbooks at the secondary level at Fatimiyah Schools.

Curriculum/Text book Screening: A curriculum screening process is put in place to screen, and supplement text material for all classes. The objective is to identify the implicit and explicit messages, if any, which tend to distort the child's, value system. All enrichments are being documented for our reference as well as to share the same with other community schools.

Quran Exhibition: The first Quran Exhibition of FEN was held on 16th & 17th June 2012 at the Basement of Bhojani Hall. Parents, teachers, students and guests were invited to the event. The exhibition gave an overview of the teaching, learning and development process of Quranic Learning at FEN. The methodology, strategies, and components of the Quran syllabus were displayed through books, activities, models and audio visual aids.

Early Childhood Development (ECD): The ECD pilot project was launched in April 2010 with 55 students. In view of the overwhelming response, seats were increased to 120 for the year 2012. Our future plans include a new building which will house the entire ECD and ECE classes. Additional facilities planned are Montessori Training Centre (MTC). The new building will Insha'Allah be completed in early 2013.

Fatimiyah Sports & Recreation Centre: The Fatimiyah Sports Centre was conceived with the need of providing quality physical activity area where the students can play in a controlled environment. The Fatimiyah Sports & Recreation Centre will be operational Insha'Allah by end of 2012 and will be open to all the students of Fatimiyah Education Network and community members. The Sports Centre will have state-of-art swimming pool, gym, 2 squash courts, and games facilities.

Fatimiyah Institute of Educational Science (FIES): This project is dedicated to achieve new standards in professional teacher education in particular and higher education in general. All its courses are upgraded multi dimensionally through a well designed and documented research process. This effort is the first of its kind on the National Level. FIES has embarked upon its journey with a 2 year B.Ed Program at Fatimiyah College, affiliated by University of Karachi. The classes are being held in the evening to facilitate in-service teachers. New session has started from Sep 5, 2012.

Teachers' Training Programs at FIES: The Fatimiyah Institute of Educational Sciences (FIES) launched a series of short courses designed to develop teachers understanding of the learning process for children at Montessori level from March to May 2012. Noted educators, child psychologists and Montessori Directress conducted the program to train new teachers and women of the community who wish to pursue a career in education.

Computer Programming & Software Engineering Courses:

FEN offered 4 months Computer Programming & Software Engineering Courses from July Oct 2012. 18 students enrolled in ASP.NET Basic course and 12 students enrolled in Adobe Photoshop.

Professional Development: The Summer Professional Development Program' sessions were held on English proficiency, and Lesson Planning, Presentations, Seminars, Discussions and Dialogue were also part of the program. In addition to these, in-house professional development sessions, by senior faculty members FEN, for new and inexperienced teachers provided insights about teaching methodology, and technical aspects of teaching. Teachers from our Community Schools Network Forum were also invited in these Training Sessions.

S.S.C Results: Congratulations to our brilliant students who have made us proud by qualifying in the S.S.C Examination 2011-12 with flying colours.

Fatimiyah Boys School:

Science Group: 72% students secured 'A1 & A' grades and 25% secured 'B' grade.

Fatimiyah Girls School:

Science Group: 85% students secured 'A1 & A' grades, 10% secured 'B' grade and 2% secured 'C' grade.

General Group: 92% students secured 'A1 & A' grades and 8% secured 'B' grade.

Merit Scholarship: Merit Scholarships are being offered to the top three students of Fatimiyah Schools (FBS-FGS) to pursue further studies at Fatimiyah College. The next ten students of each school are also offered need based scholarships for studies at Fatimiyah College.

Annual Sports Day: Celebration of Sports Day is an annual feature of Fatimiyah Schools and College. This year (2012) in line with our promise, the first annual sports event of Fatimiyah Girls School, and Fatimiyah College (Girls Campus) was held at the Pakistan Sports Board Centre on 28th Feb, 2012. The well planned and executed program was a delight for the students and parents. The Fatimiyah Boys School Annual Sports Day was held at Pakistan Sports Board Centre on 19th Feb, 2012, students participated with great energy and enthusiasm, the boys performed brilliantly in all the events. The highlight of the day was a brilliant display of the Taekwondo performed by the boys. The students of Fatimiyah Girls School and Fatimiyah College (Girls Campus) displayed similar enthusiasm and spirit as our boys.

Science Exhibition: Fatimiyah Boys School 1st Inter-school Jabir Bin Hayyan Science Exhibition was held on 25th Feb 2012. Various community and other schools were participated in the exhibition. The purpose of this inter-school competition was to provide a mechanism for students of all participating schools to express their interest in various fields of science. Projects were displayed on environmental hazards, health awareness, natural & geographical sciences. Students of FBS displayed 15 projects and every project was integrated with Hadees and Aayat.

Gym Facilities and Activities: The installation of new gym equipment at FEN has evoked a tremendous positive response from our students and faculty. The Gym and Fitness Centre of FEN has been further upgraded and new equipment made available to the students. The gym facility can be availed by members of the community during evenings.

GARDEN PLOT

KHOJA Foundation was formed by Al Haaj Mustafa Kassimali Gokal in 1982 with the aim of providing benefits to Khoja Community.

A plot of land in Garden East area which was available through the good offices of Late Mohamed Hussain bhai Dhanji, then President of KPSIAJ, was negotiated and registered in the name of the Foundation. Later the plot was being maintained by the Gokal Foundation, which was bearing all its regular expenses including payment of lease charges to Military Estate Office. On request of KPSIAJ, the Gokal Foundation allowed parking of KPSIAJ buses at the Plot which was a great help.

Looking at the performance of the present Management of KPSIAJ which continues to make progress in many fields, a discussion between KPSIAJ and Khoja Foundation took place, whereby KPSIAJ showed interest to develop the plot for their future needs. In March, 2012 the Khoja Foundation very graciously gifted the plot to KPSIAJ, for using it for the benefit of the community. All legal formalities were completed and the plot now stands transferred in the name of KPSIAJ. At the time of gift of the plot, the unoccupied area of the plot was 6,400 square yards, whereas approx. 17,500 square yards is illegally occupied.

It was very gracious of the Gokal Foundation to forego the cost of maintenance of Plot since 1982 and the charges paid to Military Estate Office, to the tune of millions of rupees. The benefit of the worth of the plot today goes entirely to KPSIAJ.
