

Dear Members,

Assalam o Alyekum

All praise to the Almighty Allah and Masoomeen (A.S) for KPSIAJ's Continued prosperity. This year our country has been hit by colossal and unprecedented floods, especially in Sindh and Baluchistan provinces. The benevolent members of our Jamaat stood up in an exemplary manner to face this challenge. We were able to provide rations, cooked foods, supplies, medicines, tents, mosquito nets and water filtration plants to the victims - which were well appreciated by the needy and by the Government of Sindh – who also gave generous support to us for the Fatimiyah Hospital, Fatimiyah Education Network and for social welfare.

In addition to the flood relief activities, we continued to provide rations to the less privileged members of our Jamaat and cash assistance to enable them celebrate Eid.

I am very pleased that this year, the Pakistan Center for Philanthropy (PCP) has recognized KPSIAJ as a PCP Certifed Not-For-Proft, after an independent assessment of all our processes, reporting structures, financial management and controls-and our programs. PCP certification is a big reward for the tireless efforts made by the Managing Committee, our employees and well-wishers of the Jamaat.

We are grateful for the visit made by President Mr. Alhaj Safder Jaffer and Secretary Mr. Arifali Hirji of World Federation, their review of our programs and the wholehearted support that we have always received from them.

As can be seen from their dashboard, the Fatimiyah Hospital had a successful year – helping close to 150K patients. A major accomplishment is the installation of CT Scan facilities (for which we are thankful to our generous donors) – which will be launched by the time we have the annual meeting. Our dental clinic also made phenomenal progress by the installation of Orthopantomogram (OPG) and Digital X-Ray equipment. Our Radiology Department also made excellent progress with the addition of Digital Radiography (DR) and Computed Radiography (CR) equipment.

The Fatimiyah Education Network continued to provide outstanding education – with well over 65% of the students getting AI or A grades – and kept the students engaged in valuable extra-curricular activities a good portion of which is enhancing the love for the Ahlul Bait. Three students from the Fatimiyah College achieved the 6th, 8th and 14th ranks in the Board of Intermediate Education examinations and this makes us really proud. Likewise, the students of FIES achieved the 1st and 2nd positions in M.Ed. examinations conducted by the University of Karachi. Congratulations to these students and their parents.

The Khoja Heritage Family Gala organized by the Pakistan Federation and KPSIAJ was very well received by the community who actively participated in the sports, academic and fun-filled activities. We are grateful to everyone who helped make this event a resounding success.

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON SUNDAY THE 26TH DECEMBER 2021, AT SHAHEED HAMID ALI BHOJANI HALL, 174, BRITTO ROAD, KARACHI.

The Annual General Meeting of the Khoja (Pirhai) Shia Isna Asheri Jamaat was held on Sunday, the 26th December 2021 at 10:30 am at Bhojani Hall, 174, Britto Road, Karachi.

Quorum was completed and the meeting commenced at 10:30 a.m. In all 190 male and 25 female members, total 215 members were present at the meeting. List placed on record.

Mr. Abul Hassan Gokal, President, requested Hon. Secretary, Hujjatul Islam Agha Asghar Hussain Shaheedi to commence the proceedings of AGM.

1. RECITATION OF VERSES FROM THE HOLY QURAN:

The Honorary Secretary Agha Asghar Hussain Shaheedi requested Mr. Mehdi Ali Haryani to recite verses from the Holy Quran.

The Hon. Secretary welcomed the members at the Annual General Meeting.

Honorary Secretary asked the members to recite Surah-e-Fateha for Marhoom Maraaj-e-Uzzam, Ulema-e-Karam, Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah, Marhoom Allama Haji Naji, Marhoom Rahim Ali Chagla, Shaheed Hamid Ali Bhojani, Shaheed Dr. Sibtain Dossa, Marhoom Dost Muhammad Bhojani, Marhoom Mohsin Hemani, Shohda of Millat-e-Jaffriya, all Marhoom Presidents and members of the Jamaat and departed souls of al Marhoom momineen and mominaat.

The Agenda was read by the Hon. Secretary Agha Asghar Hussain Shaheedi.

2. TO READ AND CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF LAST ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 20TH DECEMBER 2020:

The Hon. Secretary enquired the House whether the minutes as read (as it has been circulated to members through email and WhatsApp) and is presented for approval. Brother Altaf Kikariyawala proposed to consider the minutes of last AGM as read and approved, and Mr. Muhammad Ali Jaffery seconded, thus the minutes of AGM held on 20th December 2020 were approved and ratified by the House and adopted.

Agenda No. 4 and 5 were then taken at No.3 with the permission of members of the House.

3. TO CONSIDER AND ADOPT THE ANNUAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2021 TOGETHER WITH THE REPORT OF THE HONORARY TREASURER AND EXTERNAL AUDITOR:

The Hon. Secretary presented the audited accounts for the year ended 30the June 2021 for approval. He further said that members may ask any question related to audited accounts before it is approved. Mr. Muhammad Ali Merchant, raised following questions.

At Page No. 4 Note No.7 - Current Portion of Long-Term Loan has jumped.

On page No.13 Profit & Loss Account, membership fees increased, not showing ordinary members and there are also some differences in it, Life Membership is also not considered properly.

Increase in expenses of education, transport, and other services. If COVID-19 is considered as reason, it is 200% increased.

Retirement benefits transferred to funds of 103 million, investment in funds is decreased and transferred to short term investments and retirement benefits.

Mr. Muhammad Ali Jaffery asked about 61% increase in administrative expenses, and 53% increase in promotional expenses.

Mr. Mehboob Merchant asked about Khums Ijaza is for Hospital and Education purposes, whereas, administrative expenses have also been taken from it. He said that interest transactions are not valid but Jamaat is involved in it and asked the reason behind.

Mr. Muhammad Raza, asked the reasons of decreasing education expenses in current year as compared to last year, whereas, allocation has increased. Depreciation expenses under Note No. 9 are increased by Rs.35 million as addition, normally accounts are being signed by the President and Hon. Secretary, and this time not signed.

Mr. Shahid Saleem asked that Rs.26 million endowment funds of 2019 is not reflecting in 2021 accounts; stocks are not reflecting which is available at hospital and education sectors.

Mr. Altaf Kikariyawala suggested that no observations given by the Auditors, and therefore questions raised by the members are not valid. Only discussions about expenditure increased and decreased with suggestions be done in the AGM.

Mr. Muhammad Ali Jaffery has given his view that as per past practice, accounts have been prepared and audited, therefore, he seconded on Mr. Altaf Kikariyawala's suggestions to adopt the accounts as they are, and to save valuable time of members of the Jamaat.

Mr. Shahid Saleem suggested that reason for holding of AGM among the members is to discuss about increase and decrease in various areas of accounts, and they are not been approved until justification is given by the Management about the questions of members and stakeholders. Auditor's responsibility is to check whether accounts made are according to Accounting Standards and procedures, and gives his observations.

Mr. Muhammad Ali Merchant, suggested that all members of community have trusted on Managing Committee, they just want to get answers of their queries about increase in expenditures etc.

Mr. Asker Ali Basrawala, answered on questions raised by various members.

On Long-Term Loans of 2020, where Jamaat has availed State Bank loan facility for paying 3 month's salary of staff, so our Rs.63 million loan was jumped to 84 million, Therefore, current portion of bank loan in 2021 accounts is Rs.63 million. We have to repay 4 instalments and by the end of October 2022 - complete loan will be repaid.

Under education, deficit has increased by 1.25 million, it was challenging period for the management this year to face multiple moves of Covid-19 which has affected all business sectors. It was very difficult to defend them for all of you and also for the Management of Jamaat. We took prompt decisions, where our receipts were decreased and expenditures were increased, and it would have been increased more if we did not manage them. We have to provide welfare to parents in payment of fees. We have to consider welfare side rather than commercial side of it, where we can

enhance tuition fees to meet our additional expenditures. Our operational deficits are same as of last year. Our decrease is on other income, and people know about decrease in discount rates was from 13.25% in year 2020, and at the end of year 2021 it was 7%. Due to this decrease in interest rate, our deficits have increased.

Under medical sector, receipts have been increased as compared to last year. Due to increase in number of patients because of COVID-19, we had to manage our expenditures. Our fixed expenditures could not be decreased in a smaller period, they remain the same. Thus, pressure of increase in expenditures and normal receipts remain same so we took help from donations in this sector. We did specific fund raising in this sector which we did not do last year.

There are no major deficits in other activities, which is total Rs. 59,000 on an average of 1.96%, transport deficit is Rs.2 million which is due to fixed expenses of salaries of drivers and helpers etc., and value-added services provided due to COVID-19. This year COVID-19 pressure was comparatively lower as compared to last year, and we expect to ease out this deficit.

He answered on Mr. Muhammad Ali Merchant's questions that retirement benefits of employees of Jamaat is provident fund where amount at certain percentage is being deducted from salaries and same amount is being added by Jamaat under it in the shape of funds, which is being invested by Management to accumulate profit and is being paid to members at the time of leaving the services. Investment in TDRs at 7% per annum at the end of June 2021 and subsequently, these were matured and re-invested in higher returns offered by Banks. Present rate is 10%.

Regarding Mr. Mohsin Dharsi's question, Jamaat has availed SBP Scheme of bank loan due to Covid pressure at 3% special offered rate, in order to meet payroll expenditures during Covid-19 period. Increase in promotional expenditures, we have contacts with certain promotional media houses which help out us on media campaigns.

Regarding Mr. Shahid Saleem's question on other endowment funds which are being shown in other funds of 24 million, he answered that we did not consume any endowment funds and you can refer them from accounts. Similarly, stocks are also showing in consumable stores in balance sheet.

We have shown impact of SBP loan in hospital sector, which is a Management decision, and since during Covid period our funds were short in this sector, so we have decided to show it in hospital sector. It will not have any impact in overall level. We have availed this loan for the purpose of financing of our medical activities.

Mr. Ali Abbas, has asked about why we are not getting our accounts audited from Big-4 companies, do we have financial issues for it? Mr. Asker Ali Basrawala replied that we have appointed auditors which can do thorough audit of our accounts, sometimes, Big-4 companies do not pay due attention towards welfare organizations' audit.

He again replied to Mr. Mohsin Dharsi on his question of charging markup on SBP loan to hospital sector, that since it was originated from there and therefore, we have charged off it there.

As no further questions were raised the Hon. Secretary presented the Annual Audited Accounts along with Hon. Treasurer's Report for the year ended 30th June 2021 for approval and adoption. Mr. Muhammad Ali Merchant and Mr. Muhammad Ali Jaffery both proposed to approve the Annual Audited Accounts along with Hon. Treasurer's Report for the year ended 30th June 2021, which was seconded by Mr. Murtaza Ghabrani, Mr. Altaf Kikariyawala, Mr. Shahid Ali Khoja, Mr. Hasnain Badami, Mr. Muzammil, Mr. Yasir Devjiani, and accounts for the year ended 30th June 2021 were approved and adopted by the House.

4. TO APPOINT EXTERNAL AUDITORS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE, 2022 AND TO FIX THEIR REMUNERATION, IF ANY:

Mr. Altaf Kikariyawala proposed to appoint M/s. Dossani Associates as auditors of Jamaat for the financial year 2021-2022, which was seconded by Mr. Muhammad Ali Jaffery, Mr. Muhammad Ali Merchant, Mr. Murtaza Rajani, Mr. Mehboob Merchant, Mr. Asghar Ali Rajia. Thus M/s. Dossani Associates was appointed as auditors of Jamaat for the financial year 2021-2022.

5. TO CONSIDER AND ADOPT REPORT OF MANAGING COMMITTEE FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30-06-2021

Agha Asghar Shaheedi requested the Forum to treat the Annual Report of Managing Committees as read (as it has been circulated to members through email and WhatsApp) and is presented for approval. Brother Altaf Kikariyawala proposed to consider the Annual Report for the year ended 30the June 2021 as read and approved. Mr. Muhammad Ali Jaffery and Mr. Murtaza Ghabrani seconded. Thus, the Annual Report of Managing Committee for the year ended 30th June 2021, was approved and ratified by the House and was adopted.

6. TO CONSIDER ANY OTHER MATTER WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR:

Mr. Muhammad Ali Jaffery, asked that those married women members whose Jamaat card already made showing their husband name, then why she has been asked to submit marriage papers?

He also stated that range of Kharadar includes Lyari, Bihar Colony and a number of areas covered under it. People residing at Kharadar have to come to Soldier Bazar for availing all Jamaat facilities. It is requested to facilitate members residing in Kharadar & surrounding areas.

Mr. Ali Hussain Rajabali, refreshed managing committee about arrival time, but not mentioned ending time. Agenda must show all topics of questions and if possible, certain presentation must also be shown first before starting AGM. He also asked to discuss about income and fund raising for Jamaat, what members can do for fund raising for Jamaat. We should have to appreciate Jamaat about improvements in facilities and welfare for the benefits of Jamaat members. Also inform members about future plans of Jamaat so that those who want to help may come forward for working with Jamaat. He also pointed out that although many facilities have been arranged by Jamaat at Fatimiyah Hospital, but still a major topic is Heart treatment. We have to apologize to heart patients there and advise them to move to some other hospitals. He pointed out that members are doing criticism on some activities not performed or completed by Jamaat. There has always been a process of improvement and at every stage it is being done. However, members should also have to appreciate Jamaat about activities performed and it is a reward for Jamaat that members do appreciation of its performed activities.

FRC is doing positive work for married couples to rejoin them as much as possible, and given a second chance to married couples to continue their life in good and cooperation environment.

He suggested that needy members of Jamaat should be given 50% discount on services of Fatimiyah Hospital due to their poverty and Jamaat has to arrange donations for it.

Mr. Ghulam Hussain Faddoo, running 5 trusts at Kharadar region, pointed out that under fateha names called at the start of this session, names of Ghulam Hussain Chagla and Lalan not included.

Achievements before partition, like Chagla Musafir Khan, Ghulam Hussain Khaliqdina Trust, Ghulam Hussain Faddoo Trust etc. not named by you.

Mr. Shahid Saleem, pointed out that under report of 2019 about Women University, has not found any details about it in present report. Secondly, Jamaat should have to stop dual voting of members who are registered at another city and giving vote at Karachi also. Khums Ijaza was expired and on the basis of an old letter of Ijaza, it was bi-passed and obtained Ijaza from some other source, which I think it an un-ethical thing. His last point is about Dr. Murtaza Gowa, that he obtained 60% votes of Jamaat members, but he is not available at Hospital OPD, vaccine campaign. Also, to explain what is the difference between Governing Body and Health Board of Fatimiyah Hospital?

Mr. Mohsin Dharsi asked about per child cost in Fatimiyah Schools is Rs.5500/= which is high in the region and all other community schools. Administrative staff salary is Rs.4 million rupees which is excluding all other sectors of health, education, transport, graveyard etc. Also explain why 61% increase in expenses from 2019 to 2021.

Mr. Shahid Badami congratulated to Mr. Hassan Akbar to be the Attorney General of the year which is a pride for the Jamaat. He suggested that minutes of AGM be circulated among members within a month.

Mr. Hassan Akbar, Vice President, informed that our phone lines are working 24/7 basis, and at every moment a call or message comes, we work for it since all is being recorded. He thanked all members of the Jamaat for being awarded as Attorney General of the year, and it is Duas of members that this respect has been given to him, which is also honorable to our Jamaat.

Regarding internal control testing, Mr. Asker Ali Basrawala replied that we do establish and test our controls through Internal Audit Division which review it on regular basis and also helps in drafting the same for user departments. We can also take external review at a later date for audit and consultation. For our legal and tax issues, we take advices from our community well-wishers and act accordingly on it.

Regarding expenses of educational services, he clarified that we carry out activity about comparing our expenses of educational institutions with other educational institutions, and our fee structure is comparable with others. He appreciated previous help of Mr. Muhammad Rajpar and also thanked to him. We do deliberate attempts to reduce these expenses, so that no pressure of community be on us about pricing and fee structure. We provide fee assistance to parents of students, and do not stop any student to keep away from education because of fees payments. This is a bench mark of our education policy to provide education for all students. The flow of our expenses as compared to receipts show our deficits at every stage. We have overcome our expenses with our revenues and have much covered our deficits. In-depth review is required to go through our expenses with revenues, where our expenses are below 7 million this year. We also gave reason of increase in deficits due to treasury yields lower as compared to last year.

Due to increase in number of members of Jamaat, quorum of 45 number of members is required. This has to be enhanced, but needs constitutional amendments, which also requires not only intimation of members but also requires their suggestions. Constitution needs to be changed drastically over passage of time, it was drafted in over more than decades, and on many issues remains silent. Mr. Hassan Akbar, Vice President, said that he is working on it. Honorary Secretary, Maulana Asghar Hussain Shaheedi asked the members to come forwards with Jamaat as volunteers on different fields. It is open for all members, and show their talents voluntarily. We will put and adjust them in our various committees according to their skills. He thanked Mr. Muhammad Ali Merchant, providing his valuation suggestions and workings since 2009 on various matters and issues of Jamaat. Mr. Muhammad Zeeshan Merchant, was very helpful in making NPO status to Jamaat. Our Ex-Honorary Treasurer, Mr. Zahid Hussain Vasnani, has a great contribution in providing valuable services to Jamaat.

Honorary Secretary, Maulana Asghar Hussain Shaheedi thanked about observations of Mr. Shahid Badami about Jamaat workings and accepted his suggestions about Khoja participations and its reflections in various fields and units of Jamaat. He also replied to a member's question about signatures on all documents published for members of Jamaat. He replied that on original related documents, signatures of concerned person are there, but for public we removed them from the published and printed documents.

Mr. Yawar Abbas Kumaili, replied about Fatimiyah Hospital's expansion, he thanked donors for providing huge amount for construction of already owned plot, and another new corner plot purchasing, total cost of project is 90 crores approximately. He thanked Mr. Mohsin Ali Nathani for his valuable support of providing funds immediately for the purchase of generator for Fatimiyah Hospital. We are planning cardiac facilities too. Regarding increase in service discount to needy and poor patients up to 50%, we have 739 cases out of 1100 cases at Fatimiyah Hospital, whose salary is below Rs.30,000 per month. We have done full free treatment for all those cases who could not afford to pay at all. Our normal discount for all members of Jamaat is 10%, but for those who could not afford to pay even 50%, we adjust their cases from our welfare desk. We provide all possible funds from Sehm e Imam A.S. and Sehm e Sadaat funds.

Alhamdolillah, we along with our newly elected doctors, who are part of our Governing Body, are further working on Emergency and Pharmacy, and hope to have better results at the hospital.

CLOSURE OF MEETING

Honorary Secretary invited the President of KPSIAJ to address the members.

After the President's speech, Dua e Imam-e-Zamana A.S. was collectively recited.





HIGHER EDUCATION LOAN SCHEME (HELP)

HELP stands for 'Hiridjee Education Loan Pakistan' initiated by the World Federation

This program's main goal is to give Khoja students (both male and female) financial support so they can pursue higher education in any subject they want, both for undergraduate and graduate degrees. This will provide the finest option for students with outstanding academic credentials but are unable to continue their education owing to financial limitations.

Students only need to visit KPSIAJ's website, fill out the online application form, and attach the necessary documents to apply for this program. A Committee then reviews the application and any attachments and makes a decision based on the merits.


The repayment procedure is also quite generous: borrowing students must repay the loan amount in equal installments over a five-year period beginning the first year after graduation.

The total amount committed by the donors for tuition fees is USD 16,000 per year (cumulative requirement) over a five-year period to benefit (up to 20) qualifying students annually.

The HELP program was launched on September 22, 2021, with extensive social media promotion. To date 46 applications was submitted and 36 were approved (5 dropped out) and the approved students are already benefitting from higher education – majority in BSCS, BBA, BS and MBA. We pray for their resounding success and may they bring accolades to our community.



So far, the World Federation has assisted a number of students in studying abroad.



TELETHON

KPSIAJ organizes an annual fundraising event called Telethon to encourage its supporters to contribute financially to our projects. The annual event, which takes place during Ramadan, collects pledges from people during the live transmission of calls and messages.

This program is actively watched by a community of over 50,000 people in Pakistan and around the world via local cable and digital channels. The KPSIAJ's Executive Committee talked about their opportunities as well as challenges in their areas of Welfare, Healthcare and Education.

The visit also coincided with the most devastating floods, where The WF in collaboration with KPSIAJ carried out












GOVERNMENT OF SINDH (GOS) GRANTS

We are thankful to the Sindh Government for giving KPSIAJ the following Grants:

- 1- For Fatimiyah Hospital, GOS gave us a grant of Rs. 50 million, which was given in two installments of Rs. 25 million each. We got the second installment in the month of June 2022. Utilization of this grants can be done as follows:
 - a) 80% of the released funds shall be utilized for the purchase and installation of machinery and the medical equipment needed for the enhancement of the hospital.
 - b) Remaining 20% shall be utilized for the free or subsidized treatment of the poor and needy patients.
- 2- For Fatimiyah Education a grant of Rs. 30 million has been approved by the GOS for the current year budget.
- 3- Another grant was through the Social Welfare Department of GOS in which they have donated to us a Coffin Carrier.



SEHATMAND JAMAAT HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM

Sehatmand jamaat is a Health Insurance Plan offered by New Jubilee Life Insurance and facilitated by KPSIAJ for its Members and Employees. This scheme is also open to our community entrepreneurs for their offices and factory employees. Under this scheme one can avail various medical facilities in case of hospital admission.

The limit of the premium plan is Rs 500,000 with per day room rent of Rs 9,000, and the limit of the standard plan is Rs 200,000 with per day room rent of Rs 4,000. Pre-existing illnesses and congenital diseases are covered under this scheme.

So far, 2,705 people have benefited from the insurance program offered by KPSIAJ.

We will keep working towards increasing the effectiveness and coverage of medical insurance policy offered by KPSIAJ.



The Global Khoja Heritage Festival features free excellent food and beverages, a fun gala, sporting events, and many more educational and entertaining activities. The sport event took place on October 21, 2022 at RC Ground, Mehfil-e-Murtaza, and featured tennis & badminton for women and swimming & cricket for men.

The family gala, which involved a fun gala, free yummy food, and beverages, was hosted on October 23, 2022, at Fatimiyah Family Park.

To serve our members, we also offered a complimentary bus service from Kharadar to Fatimiyah Family Park.





WOMEN WING

Throughout the year, the women's wing was very active in organizing events like the Milad of Imam Hasan Askari (AS) at Sherbano Bagh, the Hifz e Quran program (which was attended by more than 100 people at Soldier Bazar and the Kharadar campus), Bhojani online quiz from the Khutba-e-Fadak on 20 Jamad-us-Sani and Milad on 17th Rabi-ul- Awwal at Bhojani hall.

Project Ataa-e-Fatima

KPSIAJ have launched an exclusive initiative called Ataa-e-Fatima at Fatimiyah Family Park to assist the community's children with disabilities. This project benefits many community members with special needs, and by seeing those special kids happy, our goal of spreading happiness is achieved.

Kids summer camp 2022

Women's Wing organized a special summer camp during the year where morality, ethics, religion, social contact, confidence development, and counseling were handled in a special way. Storytelling, arts and crafts, cooking, streaming, role-playing, circle of care, fabric painting, public speaking, and parties are among the activities that kids just loved.

Mammography

Breast cancer, in particular, is relatively simple to treat if detected early. In such cases, early treatment and diagnosis yield better results. Mammography is the most commonly used diagnosing method for detecting breast cancer. The Women's Wing played an important role in raising awareness and educating community women. The initiative was a collaboration between the Women's Wing, Cancer Foundation Hospital, and Fatimiyah Hospital.

Ramadhan Reset and Health Fair Program

The women's wing, through its coordinator Sukaina Muhammad Ali, organized a Ramadhan Reset and wellness fair to welcome the holy month of Ramadhan. Healthcare professionals led various seminars, including ones on Ramadan and nutritional requirements by Khadija Maisum Abbas, WB by Hemani, and mental well-being by Sukaina Hussain Ebrahim.





SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES

FLOOD RELIEF PROGRAM

Pakistan Floods - Current Situation Report

Since mid-June, monsoon rains continued to affect Pakistan by causing unprecedented floods, landslides, flash floods, and severe weather-related incidents, which have resulted in a humanitarian emergency. Over 1,730 lives were lost and almost 12,922 people were injured. Over 33 million were affected. 20.6 million people require humanitarian assistance, including around 8.2 million in flood-affected health areas need services. Widespread damage has been reported to over 2.2 million houses, The floods have displaced at least 7.9 million people, of whom nearly 640,000 displaced people are living in camps. More than 1.1 million livestock have been lost in this disaster, depriving many of their only source of income. Lack of food supplies, nutrition, medicines, camps, and hygiene, undoubtedly have increased the spread of water-borne diseases such as Typhoid and Cholera.

KPSIAJ FLOOD RELIEF PLAN

3 PHASED STRATEGY

KPSIAJ has established a three-phased strategy for providing rescue and relief to the suffering flood victims in various parts of Pakistan, particularly in Sindh and Balochistan provinces.

Phase 1 - Immediate Relief

In the first phase, basic humanitarian needs and comfort aids like food supplies, medicines, and camps have been sent to the flood victims as our top priority. We have also supplied fodder for cattle and other livestock.

Phase 2 - Rehabilitation

In the Second Phase, we are assisting in the rehabilitation process of the flood victims who have lost their shelters.

Phase - Assistance in Economic Uplift

Finally, we plan to top these efforts by providing support in the economic sustainability of flood affectees like land cultivation, seed, fertilizers etc., for flood victims across Pakistan.









During Phase 1, KPSIAJ was able to provide food, shelter, medical assistance, and cattle support to displaced and deprived flood-affected residents of Sindh and Baluchistan, through our volunteer network and collaborations with other on-the-ground organizations. H. I. Moulana Asghar Hussain Shaheedi (Hon. Secretary KPSIAJ), accompanied by KPSIAJ Management, visited the flood-affected areas and appreciated volunteers for their efforts, while also suggesting a plan for future phases.

Tent Project:

During the Immediate Relief Phase, KPSIAJ has set up tents in Usta Balochistan for around 700 beneficiaries and for 560 displaced flood-affected individuals in Sindh. In addition, Sadaat City Project was launched by KPSIAJ, where basic humanitarian essentials were provided.

Medical Support:

KPSIAJ has successfully provided medicines and launched medical camps benefitting roughly 4,980 deprived people from Sindh and Balochistan.

Chara (Cattle Breeding) Project:

About 1,072 Sindh families and 1,081 Balochistan families received enough cattle feed to last for 7-10 days and medications for cattle's from KPSIAJ.

Ration Drive and cooked food distribution:

We have successfully distributed ration bags to 15,190 underprivileged people in total. In addition, cooked food enough to feed approximately 1,000 Flood affected families has been provided by KPSIAJ. Niyaz was distributed for 7 days in the Mirpur Khas and Sukkar districts to honor the Chehlum Imam Hussain A.S, benefiting approximately 7,000 underprivileged Sindh residents.





Fumigation Activity and Mosquito Nets Distribution:

Due to the recent increase in dengue cases, KPSIAJ implemented a comprehensive plan to control infectious diseases on 40 acres of land. This activity has lasted a few months and has aided approximately 43,200 people.

In response to the anticipated threat of dengue and malaria, KPSIAJ distributed approximately 2,655 mosquito nets to flood victims in Sindh, with approximately 17,980 underprivileged individuals benefiting from them.

Water Filtration Plants and Mobile Units:

KPSIAJ organized a mobile pickup rickshaw service for the flood victims each day for two months in the majority of Sindh and Baluchistan's affected areas to assist flood victims get to water filtration plant stations and bring clean water to their shelters. Around 2,000 individuals benefit from these 4 sets of manually operated filtration plants on daily basis to filter flood water and make it consumable

RAMADAN RATION DISTRIBUTION

During this financial year in month of April 2022 corresponding the holy month of Ramzan; with collaboration with World Federation Ramzan Ration Drive was started.

Ration packs of Rs.7,200/- (enough for family of 5 for one month) were delivered to underprivileged member families at their doorstep. Two ration packs were given to around forty families having more than five family members. Altogether 1630 ration packs were delivered to community members during the holy month of Ramzan.

Beside above, 1600 ration packs were delivered to non-members (Sadaat, Non-Sadaat, Other Muslim Community and even too few deserving non-Muslim families)



CASH ASSISTANCE FOR EID-UL-FITR

On the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr, Cash Assistance (Eidi) of Rs. 5,500/- per family was extended to all deserving families. Cash assistance to 1,158 members was sent on their CNIC through Easypaisa. 433 beneficiaries over 60 years of age, received cash payments and ration at their doorsteps.







RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

The religious Sub-committee used to manage the holy days & important events like Wiladat/Shahadat of Masoomeen (AS), Ramzanul Mubarak, Eid, Moharramul Haram & Other Important holy days/events, with the prescribed post or video message by dignified Ulemas/Scholars.

The sub-Committee also managed a series of seminars on various topics covering all major aspects of human life for their spiritual development, by eminent Ulema/Scholars in Ramzanul Mubarak 1443 AH.

Ulemas from the international world were also invited to speak (ONLINE) to our community for their spiritual growth.

In-house Software Development

Our dedicated in-house software development team remained busy in continuous coordination with all departments / units for maintenance of their software. Following software went through different change requests including enhancements in existing software, new feature requests, bug fixes etc.

Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP)

With expansion of KPSIAJ services and its infrastructure, a comprehensive ERP system is essential to help streamline internal processes, better controls and increase in productivity of different departments. In coordination with Finance team, demos of different locally and internationally build ERP systems is under progress to identify a system comprehensive enough to fulfil our needs and on the other hand within affordability range. After a thorough effort shortlisting has been done. Procurement and implementation of ERP is planned to be completed within current fiscal year.

Automated WhatsApp Messenger

To facilitate members in answering their queries in timely manner without waiting for queue on phone line or to visit physically, automated WhatsApp Messenger was introduced. HUMAN RESOURCE DEPARTMENT (HR)


HR department plays a significant role in developing, reinforcing and changing the culture of an organization. our primary responsibility is to manage, assist and deal with all employee-related matters.

SECURITY

Security has been deployed at all the units managed by KPSIAJ. This department has been centralized in order to manage security more effectively and administer it with the utmost care. This department employs approximately 75 people to ensure that everything runs smoothly and efficiently.

Scrutiny, aim and fitness are some key aspects of the hiring process for any guard. Additionally, they undergo several tests throughout the year to make sure they stay healthy and active. Intercom systems and wireless Walkie Talkie sets from the Central CCTV department to all the locations ensure effective coordination and communication.



A Centralized Command and Control system has been developed, where our staff remains vigilant 24/7 to ensure no unforeseen incident takes place. Daily reporting has been made part of their job so that no event goes unheard or ignored. A number of cameras are installed on all our locations including Hussaini Bagh No. 1. Aside from the total of nearly 175+ operational CCTV cameras, more cameras are added as and when the Management sees fit. The Garden plot is also included in our surveillance project, with a number of cameras installed to make it more secure.

FATIMIYAH COMMUNITY CENTRE (GHUSAL KHANA)

Fatimiyah Community Center is providing Ghusal and Kafan facility to the members as well as public in general since 1996. Through proper Shariah compliance, cold storage and trained volunteers, Ghusal Khana aims to provide highest quality services. The facility is also regularly used by members for majalis and other programs.

KPSIAJ Management highly appreciates the volunteers (both male and female) who extend altruistic and selfless services for ghusal-o-kafan rituals.


TRANSPORTATION

FATMIYAH HOSPITAL

Fatimiyah Hospital in the year 2021-2022 continued to progress on several fronts including obtaining a provisional license by SHCC (Sind Healthcare Commission).

The year 2021-2022 was the year of technical advancement for the Hospital. FH managed to arrange the installation of a 32 Slicer CT-scan brand-new machine with all accessories imported directly from Japan through an authorized vendor. All activities, from purchasing and selection to installation, were carried out by a highly professional and dedicated team in order to achieve the desired quality and standard.

The first half of the year was highly challenging due to flood disasters and consequent diseases. With the cooperation of our dedicated professionals and team of supporting volunteers, we managed it effectively and produced the desired outcome while minimizing the impact of COVID-19.

This year we focused on our ER, ICU THEATER & Clinical Excellence. In ER we developed a new assessment format of the triplicate paper and enhanced clinical control with a daily audit module which was introduced to improve clinical practices and the satisfaction of the patient.

EMERGENCY & ICU

In ER, a separate well-equipped CPR area was developed and training of the entire team was conducted for this highly sensitive lifesaving practice to enable the FH team to handle the critically ill patient with authority, zeal and excellence.

Code blue teams were formulated and trained for every unit including ER & ICU under the supervision of senior medical staff to handle critical and sensitive events effectively and record them properly.

MEASURE TO COMBAT COVID -19 OUTBREAK

This year, like in 2020-2021, we followed the same One Patient-One Attendant policy and maintained a no-visit policy, which enabled us to support the national disaster management team to limit the spread of life-threatening COVID-19 disease.

This year, we further reduced the cost of COVID-19 screening tests to make them affordable to everyone, regardless of income.

THEATER & CLINICAL EXCELLENCE





In ICU our clinical team under the supervision surgeons developed a comprehensive one-pager sheet of individual patients monitoring for candid view and effective management of patients in the critical area of the ICU. The FH management team facilitated ICU with more High flow nasal oxygen (HFNO) devices to handle oxygen deficiencies in COVID -19 and prevent the painful process of putting them onto Ventilators. Blood warmers and many such supportive latest technologies were provided to overcome daily issues like Infusion and Syringe pumps etc.

OPG MACHINE AND DIGITAL X-RAY FOR THE DENTAL DEPARTMENT

FH was dreaming for a long to achieve technological advancement in Dentistry and Alhamdulillah we achieved these milestones this year by installing imported OPG & Digital X-Ray equipment.

RADIOLOGY DEPARTMENT & LABORATORY

This year, we also added to our Radiology Department, A qualified and experienced Radiologist for X-ray reporting by facilitating him with a new Digital Radiography (DR) machine in addition to Computed Radiography (CR).

The Radiology Department is now transforming into a more advanced technology with highly skilled qualified personnel added to oversee reporting and screening. A new Echocardiography machine is added which easily handles pediatric echoes.

FH establishment is considering the addition of MRI, Mammography, and other vital diagnostic facilities. We hired a Microbiologist and Laboratory manager In the Laboratory, who can perform all types of tests related to biochemistry and hematology.

TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

Training is an ongoing process, and the FH leadership recognized this need and assigned well-trained personnel, who will aggressively plan training for the entire clinical as well as a supportive team.

COVID VACCINATION DRIVE

A well-organized COVID vaccination drive for Part-A and Part-B COVID vaccination was organized, and it was not limited to the community; it was open to the entire Karachi population. The drive was attended by both senior citizens and children, and the outcome was encouraging. A number of people were vaccinated, and the database was well maintained thanks to the IT team and IMI volunteers.

CONTINUOUS EDUCATION AND DISEASES AWARENESS PROGRAMS

In the years 2021-2022, FH collaborated with leading private medical organizations and government authorities to organize a large number of public awareness programs on common medical issues and their early prevention.

WELFARE

During the year 2021-2022, we opened our Welfare window by extending it to all groups in order to overcome the financial problems faced by the under-privileged people. We developed a simple and practically easy welfare process and tried to protect self-esteem and privacy of all concerned in order to exercise it in more Shariah-compliant manner.
